



Applying for Financial Aid

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid - <u>FAFSA</u>
- UMB's Code is 002104
- The Pharm D program is a graduate/professional program
- Update your year in college to graduate/professional as well as your degree
- Priority filing date March 1st
- Must apply annually



Types of Aid

Fund	Amount
University Grant	Varies – based on financial need and FAFSA date
Federal Direct Stafford Loan (unsubsidized)	\$ 20,500
Federal Direct Graduate PLUS Loan	Cost of attendance minus any other aid received

- Trusted and highly accessible professionals






